

Students' Feedback Report:2020-21 Kaliabor College

IQAC, Kaliabor College prepares students' feedback form in order to collect and analyze the feedback of the students and accordingly make suggestions to the concerned authorities so as to initiate the actions for improvement. A structured questionnaire was designed and students were instructed to give responses. This survey covered 208 randomly selected students from various departments and the received information was gleaned from the response generated in the questionnaire as indicated below:

Findings:


1. Out of the total sampled students, 87.9 % of students reported the information available in the prospectus to be excellent.
2. Out of the total sampled students (89.4%) were satisfied and found the selection procedure for admission to be fair.
3. 95.1% of the students are happy with the communication skills of the teachers and marked them excellent.
4. As far as teacher's approach to teaching is concerned 89.9% of the sampled students found them to be excellent.
5. 90.8% of the sampled students believe the internal evaluation process by teachers to be fair.
6. More than half of the sampled students conveyed that the institute makes consistent and necessary efforts to engage students in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for students.
7. Most of the sampled students strongly agree that the teachers and mentoring process in the institute helps in cognitive social and emotional growth. 8. 88% of the students opined that teachers always encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.

On the basis of the ratings given by the randomly selected students for various parameters, the level of satisfaction can be considered as satisfactory. Suggestions Received: Standard scale was used to obtain the feedback from around 208 randomly selected students via online mode. Students were encouraged to pro-actively highlight both their grievances and their satisfaction. The IQAC analyzed the received feedback and chalked out few suggestions to improve the areas in which students felt the institution was lacking behind, like infrastructure, teaching method, lab facilities etc.

The suggestions were put forward to the head of the institution for further deliberation and action. Accordingly, the administration took notes of all the

recommendations of the IQAC and proper measures were taken to mitigate the fallacies. The areas of strength were also noted and furthering of those areas in which performance has been above satisfactory has been assured for the coming session.


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Report on Teachers' Feedback 2020-2021

This report is prepared on the basis of the analysis of data collected from the faculty members of the college. Feedback on various grounds was sought from 50 teaching members of the institute with the help of a structured questionnaire. 11 questions were framed which essentially captured the various academic and administration aspects of the college. The results were analysed using various statistical tools and they are as follows:

1. The responses clearly indicate that the majority of teachers are very satisfied with the curriculum objectives and the outcomes. They feel that curriculum objectives and outcomes are clearly defined to the teachers and students.
2. 76% of the teachers think that there is a good balance between theory and practical in the courses.
3. More than 50% of the respondents are satisfied with the course contents. They have provided 'good' as the feedback rating while evaluating the course content from the view of needs of the students.
4. A very high percentage of teachers (72%) are satisfied with the eagerness and attendance of the students.
5. 82% of the respondents rated the availability of reference books/magazines/other study materials in the college library in the range 'good' to 'very good' whereas 12% teachers rated it as 'satisfactory'.
6. 72% of the teachers responded the availability of reading rooms, well-furnished classrooms, toilets, well equipped laboratories and playgrounds in the college campus in the range 'good' to 'very good' and 20% of them rated it 'satisfactory' as the feedback rating.
7. About 52% of the respondents seems to be satisfied with the clean drinking water facilities in the college campus.
8. 79% of the teaching staff are satisfied and 14% of them are very satisfied with the output of the students.
9. 52% of the respondents strongly agree and 44% of the teaching staff agree to the point that the college authorities are approachable and accessible.
10. 52% of the teaching members of college agree and 48% of them strongly agree that the office staff of the college is approachable and accessible.

11. A very high percentage of respondents feel that the college has adequate medical facilities and is equipped to handle medical emergencies of the students and teachers.

Suggestions given by the teachers:

1. The course curriculum should be more balanced in theoretical and practical knowledge.
2. More ICT facilities are required.
3. Medical facilities are to be upgraded.
4. Attendance of the students must be made compulsory.
5. Improvement in Wi-Fi and internet facilities in the campus required.
6. More emphasis should be given to placement of students.



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Alumni Feedback Report 2020-21


This report is prepared on the basis of the analysis of data collected from the Alumni of the college. Feedback on various aspects was taken from 50 alumni of the college with the help of a structured questionnaire. 11 questions were framed which essentially include the various aspects like academics, administration, infrastructure development, alumni development etc. The results were analyzed using various statistical tools and they are as follows:

1. 84.6 % of the alumni responded to have been highly satisfied with the teaching-learning process in the programme they pursued in the institute while enrolled in study.
2. 92.8 % of them reported to have been satisfied with the library facilities of the college.
3. 92% of the alumni were satisfied with the academic environment of the college.
4. 80% of the respondents rated the development activities organized by the college for all round development as 'highly satisfactory'.
5. 78.5 % of the respondents rate the teacher-student relationship in Kaliabor College as 'highly satisfactory'
6. 100% of the respondents are eager to become members of the Kaliabor College Alumni Association while 90% would recommend their relative/friends to enroll at Kaliabor College.
7. 75% of the respondents receive regular updates from the college through Mails/Calls/SMS/Facebook etc.

Suggestions given by Alumni:

1. Timely expansion and updation of the alumni association must be maintained on regular basis.
2. Alumni meet should be held on regular basis to foster a sense of community among alumni.
3. More developmental activities should be organized for the all-round development of the students.

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Report on Parents' Feedback 2020-21


Parents feedback is considered as vital for the development of any academic institution. Feedback is taken manually from the parents by organizing parents meets by various departments of the college independently.

1. The rating for almost all the questions fell in the range 'satisfied' to 'highly satisfied'.
2. Parents selected the rating 'highly satisfied' while evaluating the process of admission adopted by the college.
3. Parents also rated the academic environment of the college 'very good' (60%) where they found that the academic atmosphere is conducive for the overall development of their wards.
4. The majority of the parents (56%) are highly satisfied with the college authorities and the office staff regarding any queries. They mentioned that the authorities are easily approachable in dealing with student related issues.
5. About 52% of the parents are highly satisfied with the hostel facilities provided by the college.
6. The campus facilities of the college is also highly commended by most of the parents. 29% of the parents are highly satisfied with the campus facilities and 43% of the parents have provided 'excellent' as the feedback rating regarding the campus facilities.

Suggestions given by Parents:

1. Parents felt that there is a need of improvement in the placement and internship opportunities by the college.
2. They opine that parent-teacher-student interaction sessions should be organized regularly.
3. The parents believe that overall personality development of students should be emphasized on, by introducing courses on public speaking, human resource management skills and other soft skills relevant to the 21st century.

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
