REPORT ON THE SIGNING OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)
BETWEEN KALIABOR COLLEGE AND A.D.P. COLLEGE, NAGAON


On 12 November 2025, an important academic milestone was achieved with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Department of Mathematics, Kaliabor College, Kuwaritol, and the Department of Mathematics, Anandram Dhekiel Phookan (A.D.P.) College, Nagaon.

The formal signing ceremony was held at A.D.P. College, graced by the presence of **Dr. Sadananda Payeng, Principal of A.D.P. College, Dr. Nitin Sarma, Head of the Department of Mathematics, and faculty members of the department.** From Kaliabor College, the MoU was officially signed by the **Principal Dr. Uttam Kumar Baruah at Kaliabor College** itself, while the institution was represented at the ceremony by **Mr. Binod Kr. Sah, Head of the Department of Mathematics, along with faculty members.** Their participation reflected a shared commitment to promoting academic excellence and inter-institutional cooperation.

The MoU sets a forward-looking framework for collaboration aimed at advancing Mathematical Sciences through coordinated efforts. Both departments agreed to engage in joint research, faculty and student exchange, curriculum enrichment, and innovative teaching-learning practices. To ensure effective implementation, coordinators from both departments will oversee the planning and monitoring of activities, supported by mechanisms for regular review and progress evaluation. Valid for three years (2025–2028), this MoU is expected to strengthen teaching-learning processes, enhance research productivity, and foster intellectual growth. It will further solidify institutional ties and support the advancement of Mathematics education in the region, reaffirming the shared dedication of both departments to building a vibrant, knowledge-driven academic environment.



Preamble:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between the Department of Mathematics, Kaliabor College (hereinafter referred to as "Kaliabor") and The Department of Mathematics, Anandram Dhekial Phookan College (hereinafter referred to as "ADP") to foster academic collaboration and enhance the quality of education and research in Mathematical Studies.

Objectives:

The primary objectives of this Mou are:

1. To felicitate faculty exchange for lectures, workshops, seminars and research collaborations.
2. To promote student exchange for academic enrichment and cultural exposer.
3. To enable the sharing of academic resources, including library materials, digital resources and equipments.
4. To organize joint academic events, such as conferences, seminars and workshops.
5. To encourage collaborative research projects and publications.
6. To enhance the overall academic environment and promote intellectual exchange between the two institutions.

Areas of Collaboration:

The following areas of collaboration will be pursued under this MoU:

- **Faculty Exchange:**
 1. Exchange of faculty members for delivering lectures, conducting workshops and participating in seminars.
 2. Collaborative research projects and joint publications.
 3. Sharing expertise in curriculum development and pedagogical innovation.
- **Student Exchange:**
 1. Exchange of students for short-term academic programs and cultural exchange.
 2. Participation in joint student seminars and workshops.
 3. Access to library other academic resources at the host institution.
- **Asset Sharing:**
 1. Sharing of library resources, including books, journals and digital databases.
 2. Exchange of teaching and research materials.
 3. Access to specialized equipment and facilities, as mutually agreed upon.
- **Joint Academic Events:**
 1. Organization of joint conferences, seminars and workshops.
 2. Collaborative organization of literary and cultural events.
 3. Co-sponsorship of guest lectures.
- **Collaborative research:**
 1. Joint research projects on mutually agreed upon topics.
 2. Joint publications and presentations.
 3. Sharing research methodologies and data.
- **Implementation and Co-ordination:**
 1. Each department will designate a coordinator to oversee the implementation of this MoU.
 2. Regular meetings will be held between the coordinators to discuss and review the progress of collaborative activities.
 3. Specific terms and conditions for each collaborative activity will be agreed upon in writing before implementation.
 4. Financial arrangements for each collaborative activity will be discussed and agreed upon on a case-by-case basis.
- **Review and Amendment:**
 1. This MoU will be reviewed annually by the coordinators from both departments.
