





This Memorandum of Arrangement is entered into this <sup>19<sup>th</sup></sup> day of <sup>August</sup> June, 2019, between the Department of Chemical Sciences, Tezpur University (henceforth DCS-TU), a Department established in 1997 under Tezpur University, a University established by an Act of Parliament, represented by the Head of the Department, as the **First Part**,

**AND**

**Kaliabor College, Kuwaritol, Kaliabor** (hereinafter referred as KC), established in 1969 with affiliation to Gauhati University, having its campus at Kuwaritol, Kaliabor, Nagaon District, PIN - 782137, Assam, represented by its Principal as the **Second Part**.

#### **Avenues and Collaboration:**

##### **I. Guest Lectures and Students' Internship:**

The DCS-TU agrees to encourage its faculty members to participate at KC as Guest Lecturer and to provide guidance to Students of KC as Intern whenever possible. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the concerned faculty member(s) of TU and KC extending such an invitation.

The members of faculties and students of KC are encouraged to undertake short visits to TU for possible educational assignments. The faculty members of the DCS-TU agree to deliver scientific talks, popular talks, tutorial for UG courses, special lectures on important topics or under the domain of specific expert, lesson for laboratory courses, conduct short workshops, seminars etc. on expressing their need. Both institutions will examine ways to identify financial resources to support travel, remuneration/stipend, etc. for the faculty and/or students.

##### **II. Collaborative Extension Activities:**



The DCS-TU and KC encourages collaboration between members of faculty from the two institutions. It has been proposed that extension activities, especially in quality drinking water at Kaliabor locality will be taken up with an initiative of the College.

The works will be implemented mainly by the college with laboratory testing of water and technical support in water purification from DCS-TU. KC will take initiatives in collection of water samples, organization of awareness programs and water purification training programs, installation of filters and their maintenance. DCS-TU will extend possible supports in testing of water, resource persons for awareness and training programs and technical supports in installation of filters. The terms and conditions for the works will be worked out jointly by DCS-TU and KC.

### **III. Conservation of Cultural Museum of the College:**

Collaborative steps will be taken up by KC and DCS-TU for conservation of the College Cultural Museum. The College will organize small workshops for conservation of wood carvings with original traditional paints and for conservation of Sancipat Manuscripts by noncorrosive method with technical help from DCS-TU. Any financial matters involved in the works will be settled mutually by the two parties.

### **IV. Other Activities:**

In addition to the above areas of activities, DCS-TU and KC agree to establish relationship for collaborative academic, research and outreach activities in any other areas of mutual interest, identified in due course of time, and in accordance with terms and conditions stated in this memorandum of Arrangement (MoA).

### **V. Tenure and Termination:**

This MoA will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. This MoA will be considered invalid if either one will send a written notice to the other institution at two months in advance. The DCS-TU and KC



ensure that all activities will be in progress and are allowed to complete successfully. However, after termination of this MoA, neither DCS-TU nor KC will be responsible for any suffer.

This MoU is signed subject to approval of the respective academic / administrative bodies.

**1. Preamble:**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day 23<sup>rd</sup> May, 2023 between **THE ASSAM ROYAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY**, a state private University, established by The Assam Royal Global University Act 2013 (to be read with The Assam Private Universities Act 2007), notified by the Government of Assam Gazette on 23/8/2013, herein after referred to as "**FIRST PARTY/RGU**", having its campus at Betkuchi, NH-37, Guwahati-781035, Assam. Starting its first academic session from July 2017, RGU currently offers multiple courses in diversified fields.

And

**KALIABOR COLLEGE**, established on 26 July 1969, is a fast growing institution of higher education in middle Assam. Kaliabar College, herein after referred to as "**SECOND PARTY/KALIABOR COLLEGE**", have been catering quality education in Arts, Science and Commerce in affordable price to this large area of Nagaon district as well as parts of Sonitpur, Karbi

Anglong and Golaghat districts. At present the college offers professional courses like BBA, Bio-technology and Computer Science in addition to B.Voc course on Small Tea Garden Management and Tourism & Services Industry. The college was brought under deficit grant system in the year 1975 and subsequently provincialised in 2005.

**The Assam Royal Global University, Guwahati and Kaliabor College** hereinafter collectively referred to as 'the Parties/ Universities/ Institutions' and individually as 'the Party/University/Institution'.

## **2. Purpose:**

That the broad objective of this agreement is to have a common platform for Research / Faculty and Student Exchange Program/ Summer & Winter Internship/ Projects/ Joint Consultancy/ Joint Training Programs/ Effective implementation of NEP 2020 also considering issues related to nirf and UGC notifications on UTSAH and PoP etc. and other activities as agreed upon by both the parties.

## **3. Statement of Mutual Benefits & Interests:**

- 3.1 Together, these two parties shall work towards furthering cooperation in both education, training & academic research which will be mutually beneficial for both institutions.
- 3.2 Parties shall work in cooperation for research activities; joint training programs; exchange of faculty members; summer programs; student exchange; joint publications & sharing of information, etc. in addition to taking advantage of RGU's multi-disciplinary, inter-disciplinary, vocational degree thus providing benefit to the students of the college under the NEP 2020 scenario.

## **4. Forms of Cooperation:**

The Parties envisage the following cooperation within the scope of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU):

### **4.1: Exchange of Faculty members:**

For planning and handling of academic programs and courses, organization of seminars, workshops and conferences including the exchange of mutual experiences in teaching, research and industrial practices with prior approval from parent institutions. Honorarium, transportation and accommodation/hospitality as per institution norms.

### **4.2: Exchange in Research:**

Through joint programs in research and development, including provision of Summer/Winter Internship Programme for the students of RGU and vice versa. During the period, either institution will provide hostel accommodation to the visiting students as per the institution norms. Prior approval and agreement of the Head of the concerned department of the institutions is to be obtained to allow students to work in laboratories for projects, internships, etc. Vice-Chancellor/Registrar/Principals of the universities/institutions will be the sole authority to grant final approval.

**4.3: Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects:**

RGU faculty will involve some of the selected faculties depending upon their interest and expertise in the chosen domain of Kaliabor College to be Co-investigators in their project proposals for funding and vice-versa. Faculty members involved in any such projects will need to seek prior approval from respective Heads of the Institution.

**4.4: Seminars / Symposia / Workshop/ Training Programs to be jointly organized:**

To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs, to organize seminars, conferences, training programs or workshops on topics of mutual interest, and invite faculty members from both the institutions to participate therein. However, for specific co-operation, projects shall be negotiated separately between the Parties and in each specific case shall be established as separate written agreements, stating the respective rights and obligations of the Parties.

**4.5 Co-Curricular activities (Sports, culture, debate, quiz etc.):**

RGU and Kaliabor College may conduct some Inter-University joint events, joint camps, training for specific sports etc. with mutual consultation.

**5. Financial Obligations:**

There will be no financial obligations on both the Parties under this agreement.

**6. General Coordinators:**

Each Party shall designate an administrative office/ department to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this MoU.

**7. Intellectual Property Rights:**

RGU and Kaliabor College agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. Further, all rights linked to ideas, inventions and patents generated during the MoU, shall remain the common intellectual property of the Parties. The Parties shall not pass on or give usage rights of such property to any third party without the consent of the other party.

**8. Dispute Settlement:**

In the event of any dispute or difference arising under this Agreement, the Parties shall try to discuss and arrive at an amicable resolution thereof. If the Parties fail to arrive at an amicable resolution within (thirty) 30 days of the dispute having arisen, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator appointed pursuant to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral proceedings shall be held in Guwahati and the language of arbitration shall be English. The Parties agree that the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the Parties. The arbitration tribunal shall also decide on the costs of the arbitration procedure.

**9. Liability:**

Except for loss or damages caused through gross negligence or intent, the Parties shall have no liability to each other hereunder.

**10. Force Majeure:**

Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to eventualities like floods, earthquakes, strikes, bandhs, lockouts, epidemics, riots and commotions, etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation or cessation of such events, the party affected thereby shall give notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond four months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

**11. Legal Relationship:**

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be constructed to create any legal relationship between the Parties.

**12. Coming into Force, Amendment and Termination:**

This MoU shall come into force from the date of its signatures and shall remain valid for a period of 5 years. This MoU may be modified, renewed or extended with the mutual written consent of the Parties. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months' notice in writing to the other Party.


