PROHIBITORY ORDER U/S 163 BNSS

Whereas, the HSLC and HSSLC Examination, 2025 will be held from 13th February 2025 to 17th March 2025 at various centres in Nagaon District,

Whereas, it is anticipated that a large number of parents and guardians of the candidates may gather in and around the examination centres, which could lead to noise and unwarranted disturbances,

Whereas, I am satisfied that emergent steps are required to be taken to prevent any untoward incident/ atmosphere which may likely cause breach of peace and tranquility during the examination period,

And, whereas, I am satisfied that antisocial elements may disturb the examinations and likely to cause disturbances in peaceful conduct of HSLC, HSSLC and Assam High Madrasa Examination, 2025.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 163 BNSS I, Narendra Kumar Shah, IAS, District Magistrate, Nagaon, do hereby prohibit the following throughout all Examination centres of the District-

1. No person will be allowed within the radius of 50 meters of Examination centres except the following category of persons-
 - a) Students appearing in the examination (with valid Admit card duly signed by the competent authority),
 - b) Concerned College/ School Teachers, invigilator, supervisory/office staff and checking squad associated with the examination,
 - c) Agencies of the Government involved in the enforcement of law and order and the maintenance of essential services and any Government employees/officials engaged in the conduct of the examination.
2. No Parking and plying of vehicles will be allowed within the radius of 50 meters from the examination centre except that of authorized person on duty during the examination period.
3. Mobile phones, calculators and any other communication device such as Bluetooth, Wi-fi etc. shall not be allowed inside the Examination centre / premise except that of centre in-charge and authorized person on duty.
4. No food stall, shops etc. will be allowed within the radius of 50 mtrs of Examination centres.
5. No other person will be allowed to guide candidates for sitting on their allotted seats except the supervisory staff of Examination centre.
6. Use of loudspeakers near the examination centres during the exams is Prohibited.


This order copy should be displayed in front of Entry Gate of all Examination centres.

Owing to the necessity of the situation, this order is passed ex-parte under section 163 BNSS. However, anyone aggrieved by the order may approach the competent authority for modification/waiver/ alteration/rescind of the order.

This order will come into effect immediately throughout Nagaon district and will remain in force until 17th March 2025, or until further order.

Any violation of this order is punishable U/S 223 BNS or other existing provisions of law.


