RULES & REGULATIONS

Students admitted into an academic programme must adhere to the rules and regulations laid down by the college authorities. Violation of the rules, unruly conduct and indiscipline, disrespect to the authority and the faculty and staff as well as seniors will be severely dealt with.

Ragging and bullying in any form or manner will be strictly punished.

GENERAL RULES

A student cannot organize gatherings, meetings and demonstrations without the prior permission of the college authorities. Such gatherings, meetings and demonstrations will be considered irregular and strict action may be taken in such matters. Only recognized student bodies like the duly elected Students' Union will have the right of representation in student-related issues. Formation of students' forums, societies and associations etc. must come under the supervision of the college authorities.

RULES REGARDING USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

Students are advised to exercise self-regulation, caution and discretion in the use of the various platforms of social media. Abusive and obscene posts and updates on platforms such as Facebook, WhatsApp and others often prove to be incriminating in the eyes of the law of the land. The College authorities will take strict action against abusive posts either generated or shared by misguided students. Such students will be immediately handed over to the law enforcing agencies.

ATTENDANCE

A student must attend a minimum of 75% classes in an academic year. Students failing to attend the minimum percentage will be debarred from appearing in the sessional, mid-term and end-term examination. A student who is unable to attend the minimum attendance for bona fide reasons must produce a leave note forwarded by the head of the department to the Vice Principal's office. Leave notes must be furnished with necessary documents with credible reasons. The college reserves the right to disqualify a student who fails to attend classes for a long stretch of time without a leave note or permission of the college authority.

RULES DURING EXAMINATIONS

A student must appear in all internal examinations, projects and viva conducted by the college and must complete home assignments and internships as advised. Failure to appear in the internal examinations will lead to restriction from filling up of external examination form. Failure to present proper documents like admit cards may lead to action by the Examination Board. Unruly conduct and adoption of unfair means in the examination hall on the part of the examinee may lead to expulsion from the examination hall.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

Students inside the college campus must adhere to a uniform dress code. Violation of the dress code will lead to expulsion from the college with immediate effect. The dress code is as follows:

Boys: White shirt and black formal trousers (jeans trousers are strictly forbidden) and maroon pullovers or sweaters (for winter).

Girls: White chador with green border and muga-coloured mekhela or white salwar-kameez and green Jaipuri dupatta or bandhni and maroon pullovers or sweaters (for winter). Leggings and Patiala salwars are strictly forbidden.

IDENTITY CARD

A student must carry her/his identity card at all times in the college campus. The ID card, issued at the time of admission must be produced as and when demanded by the college authorities or security personnel.

LIBRARY



Established in 1969, the Central Library at Kaliabor College stands as a significant repository of knowledge among college libraries in Assam. From its modest beginnings in a small room, the library has evolved with the overarching goal of becoming an exemplar among college libraries in the region and the state. The primary objective is to serve the college community in the pursuit of knowledge, consistently striving to adopt best practices in all facets of its activities.

The library plays a crucial role as an information hub not only for the college but also for the local community. Boasting a collection of over 43,000 books, the library is committed to providing open access to its diverse range of resources. PRIVILEGE OF ISSUING BOOKS

SPORTS

The college has an integrated sports complex including a Twin-Field. The indoor stadium of the integrated sports complex houses a badminton court and facilities for table-tennis. It also has a well-equipped gymnasium and a basketball court.

NCC

Kaliabor College NCC under 8 Assam BN NCC/ Tezpur Group offers opportunities to the bonafide students of Kaliabor College to enroll and experience in co-curricular activities, building unity and discipline. Cadets of the NCC have earned laurels for the unit. The current intake of the unit is 75 (45 SD and 30 SW)

NSS

The college has a full-fledged NSS wing which plays an important role in sensitizing the students on various social issues. The intake capacity of the unit is 50.

STUDENTS' UNION

The college provides the students with the opportunity to represent themselves in the matters of the college with a vibrant Students' Union which is elected every year.

MEDICAL CELL:

The college has a dedicated medical cell with a designated faculty member to deal with medical emergencies that may come up in the college.

CANTEEN:

The college has a two-storey canteen which has separate areas for faculty members and students. It provides for refreshments to the patrons during the college hours.

HOSTEL:

The college has hostel facilities for both male and female students. The hostels are overseen by a warden who is a faculty of the college. Applications for admission into the hostels have to be submitted separately. Intake capacity: Boys Hostel: 60 boarders; Girls' Hostel: 55 boarders.

DRINKING WATER FACILITIES:

The college has adequate filtered drinking water facilities both centrally and also within various departments.

CAREER COUNSELING AND PLACEMENT CELL
