Admission will be conducted as per NEP-2020 and the Director of Higher Education for the Four-Year Undergraduate Program (FYUGP) under Gauhati University as per regulations framed by Kaliabor College (Autonomous). ATTENDANCE

A student who is unable to attend the minimum attendance for bona fide reasons must produce a leave note forwarded by the head of the department to the Vice Principal's office. Leave notes must be furnished with necessary documents with credible reasons. The college reserves the right to disqualify a student who fails to attend classes for a long stretch of time without a leave note or permission of the college authority.

RULES DURING EXAMINATIONS

A student must appear in all internal examinations, projects and viva conducted by the college and must complete home assignments and internships as advised. Failure to appear in the internal examinations will lead to restriction from filling up of external examination form.
